Proposal

An Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendment application for a 15-storey (58 metres including the mechanical penthouse) mixed-use building with 278 square metres of retail space on Davenport Road and 105 residential units. A total of 124 parking spaces are proposed in a 4-level underground parking garage with access off Davenport Road. A separate application under the Rental Housing Demolition and Conversion Control By-law has also been submitted to demolish six residential rental units on-site.

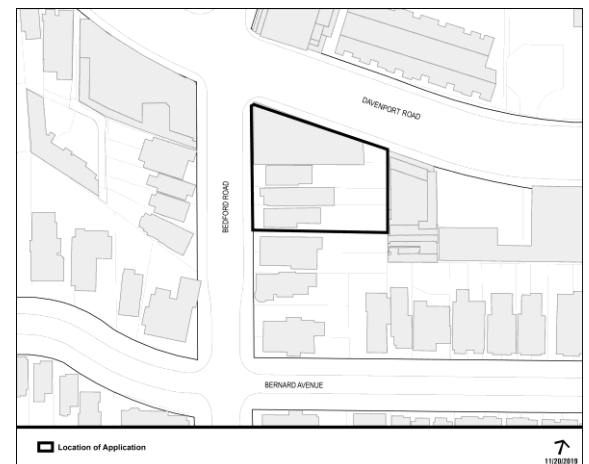
