
## Planning Application For: 78-90 Queen's Park

The City is holding a second community consultation meeting online where you can learn about the revisions to this application, ask questions and share your comments.

### Proposal

The City has received an application at 78-90 Queen's Park to amend the Zoning By-law to permit a 9-storey institutional building on the site that would include a recital hall, laboratories, work areas, meeting rooms, offices and a cafe. Falconer Hall is proposed to be substantially retained and integrated into the development while the McLaughlin Planetarium is proposed to be demolished.



The first community consultation meeting was held in June 2019 and the purpose of this meeting is to present and discuss revisions that have been made to the proposal.
